Psalm 91



We live in an incredibly challenging and dangerous time in human history. From a world-wide pandemic to racial division to economic melt-down to political upheaval and beyond... these are unprecedented times. Or are they? A careful read though Psalm 91 will help you realize that though the issues may be new, the root challenges

are not new. Psalm 91 doesn't mince words as it lays out in specific terms the fearful things we humans are up against as we live life on this little blue ball spinning around a fire ball in the middle of outer space. Traps... nightmares... destruction... lions... serpents... deadly pestilence... trouble... it's all there. Mixed in with those things though - and here's the hope - is an absolute assurance that God is in the fray with you. He is our shelter... refuge... fortress..covering. He guards us... shields us... delivers us... protects us... answers us. He is with us. He is the shadow under which we reside... safe and sound.

Verses 14 & 15 are particularly key as the Lord sums this dance between the dangers of life and the security He brings by reminding us of the fact that we must continue to...

HOLD FAST TO HIM. KNOW HIS NAME. CALL TO HIM.

HOLDING ONTO... KNOWING... CALLING OUT TO... those are the keys to going deeper with Jesus. How you do those things is best discovered in the daily pursuit of Him. May you discover how best to do that as you spend time with Him in the days ahead.
